

PETITION FOR REVIEW

Pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 402(a), 28 U.S.C. §§ 2112, 2342(1), and 2344, and Rule \$\frac{15}{15}(a)\$ of the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure, Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless ("Verizon Wireless") hereby petitions the Court for review of the final order of the Federal Communications Commission (the "Commission" or the "FCC"), captioned Service Rules for the 698-746, 747-762 and 777-792 MHz Bands, Second Report and Order, FCC 07-132, WC Docket No. 06-150, which the Commission adopted on July 31, 2007 and released on August 10, 2007 ("Report and Order"). The Commission published the Report and Order in the Federal Register on August 24, 2007, see 72 Fed. Reg. 48814-01. A copy of the full text of the Report and Order is attached as EXHIBIT A to this Petition for Review.

This Petition for Review is timely pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 402(a) and 28 U.S.C. § 2344. This Petition for Review is also filed within the 10-day period prescribed for participation in any lottery conducted pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 2112 and 47 C.F.R. § 1.13(a)(1). Venue is proper in this Court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2343.

Verizon Wireless seeks judicial review on the grounds that the Report and Order exceeds

the Commission's authority under the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. §§

151, et. seq., violates the United States Constitution, violates the Administrative Procedure Act,

5 U.S.C. § 701 et. seq., and is arbitrary, capricious, unsupported by substantial evidence and

otherwise contrary to law. Verizon Wireless challenges that part of the Report and Order which

adopts what the Commission refers to as an "Open Platforms for Devices and Applications"

mandate as part of the service rules for the C Block of spectrum in the upcoming 700 MHz

auction.

Accordingly, Verizon Wireless respectfully requests that this Court hold unlawful,

vacate, enjoin, and set aside the challenged portion of the Report and Order, and provide such

additional relief as may be appropriate.
