






Change Status







Over a specific time window





Caveats & Limitations



Max of 10,000 rows per request

- Requests must be limited to specific date windows
- Request must include a limit

- Requests must be limited to specific date windows
- Request must include a limit
- Only some resources support change history at this time
- Not all clients generate change events
 - AdWords API* calls won't generate change events but will appear in change status
