Customers might ask...

How does this redesign compare to the old Nest app?

The updated Google Home app works with all Nest cameras and doorbells, so you no longer need to keep both the Nest and Google Home apps installed if you have a mix of old and new Nest cameras. The new camera and history viewers in Google Home include some of the most popular features from the Nest app.*

Do I have to buy all new devices?

No. Devices that currently work with Google Home and “Works with Google Home” devices will continue to work. Some may receive automatic updates to make them Matter compatible.†

Will my smart home device retroactively support Matter?

Over 400 smart home brands already support Matter, and many are releasing updates to make existing devices Matter compatible. To find out about future compatibility for specific devices, look for information from the device’s manufacturer.†

Do I need multiple hub devices to use different ecosystems?

The Matter hub in Nest devices is specifically designed to work with the Google Home ecosystem.† If you want to use Matter devices with another platform, you’ll need a hub for that ecosystem. Thread is different – the Thread border router in Nest devices will work with other compatible platforms too.
