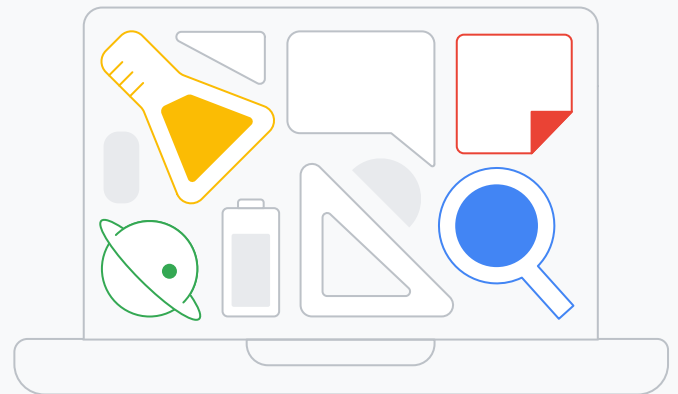

Install and allowlist Classroom add-ons so educators and students can use their favorite education technology tools, without leaving Classroom.

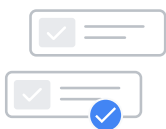
