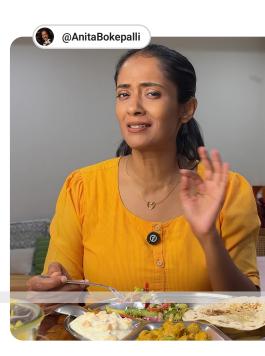

In just two decades, YouTube has fundamentally reshaped how we watch and create entertainment. By giving "Creator Nation" more ways than ever to make money on YouTube, we're giving them more opportunity to reinvest in their content, teams, and operations.

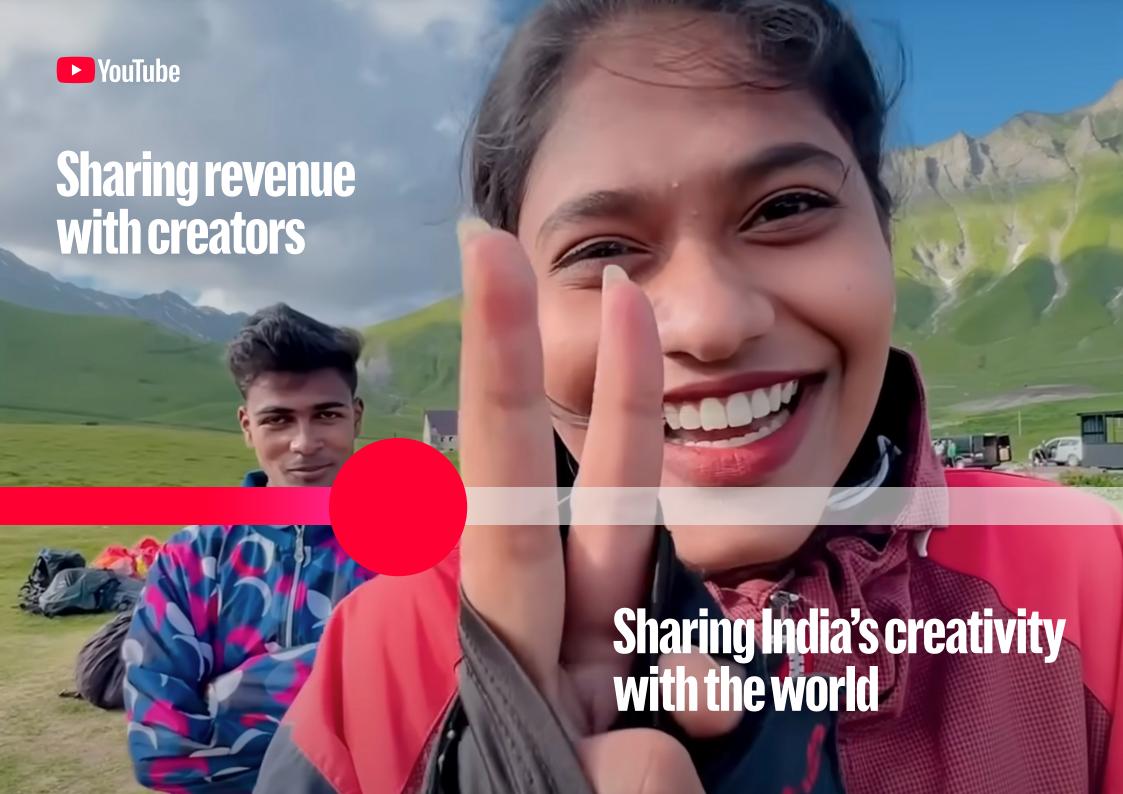

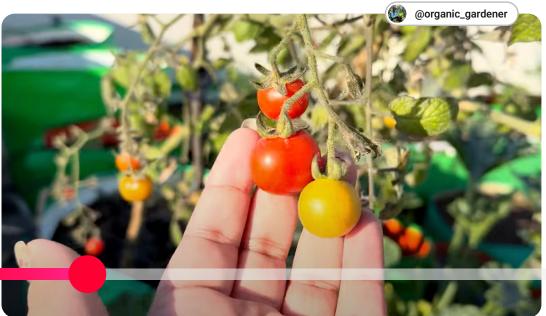

How we share revenue with creators

Our revenue-sharing model, the YouTube Partner Programme, pays creators a majority of the revenue generated from advertising and YouTube Premium subscriptions.

Advertisers use YouTube to reach an engaged audience viewing creator content. YouTube then shares the revenue generated from advertising with creators.

This empowers creators to build audiences and launch careers. But creators don't just sustain themselves. They help strengthen the Indian economy by creating jobs, hiring teams, developing talent, and launching ventures that span beyond YouTube.

Monetising through the YouTube Partner Programme*

Over the years, we've continued to invest in new monetisation options for creators beyond advertising. There are now multiple ways creators can earn money from revenue sharing and fan engagement.

For example, Super Chat is a fan engagement feature where viewers can purchase a highlighted message in a video's chat stream that stands out from the crowd to get more attention from their favourite creators.

Tools like these increase creators' earnings and help them build their community.

Helping Indian businesses reach new audiences and build stronger brands

Just as individual creators find entrepreneurial success on YouTube, small and medium businesses (SMBs), media, and music companies also leverage the platform to create content and promote brands to new customers.

SMB content can range from tutorials and how-to guides about their products to behind-the-scenes glimpses that build brand trust and authenticity. Media and music companies use YouTube to expand their global reach and find new audiences through innovative distribution formats. At the same time, India's workers benefit from YouTube's free training and upskilling resources.

YouTube provides an array of powerful tools that fuel business growth and expansion. Beyond the shared ad revenue from the YouTube Partner Programme, businesses benefit from increased brand awareness (aided by our personalised recommendation systems), direct sales via YouTube Shopping, fan funding options, and more.

These tools lead to a more engaging shopping experience, a wider audience, greater reinvestment in the business, and a sales pipeline that can't be found anywhere else.

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Crazy XYZ transformed a career path while celebrating a love of science

Crazy XYZ, led by IIT Roorkee graduate and creator Amit Sharma, is a shining example of how YouTube can turn curiosity and creativity into a thriving business. What began as casual experimentation during college evolved into one of India's most watched science and engineering channels, featuring jaw-dropping experiments, creative challenges, and educational content.

Starting in 2016 with a simple repair video, Amit quickly learned the importance of originality. His viral "Bike Vs Road Roller" video was a major turning point, racking up 34 million views and helping to confirm the potential of large-scale experiments and YouTube's recommendation algorithm. *Crazy XYZ*'s videos now regularly reach millions of viewers, largely discovered via homepage suggestions and trend-driven Shorts.

YouTube enabled Amit to turn down a high-paying job and instead build a sustainable business, powered by his own knowledge, interests, and inventive spirit. With 90% of his income stemming from YouTube — largely through brand sponsorships and AdSense — he's grown a 30-person team, invested in a 61,000-square-foot studio, and launched educational products like Crazino's science kits.

Beyond business, YouTube has empowered Amit to educate rural communities, inspire students, and develop life-saving awareness campaigns. It's also personally transformed him from a shy student to a confident communicator and leader. For *Crazy XYZ*, YouTube has been a life-changing engine for innovation, impact, and independence.

Shreemani Tripathi provides a fresh perspective in tech and inspiration to millions

Shreemani Tripathi's journey from digital marketing and scriptwriting into tech-focussed YouTube content creation is a testament to the platform's power to transform passion into a thriving career. Inspired by a gap in the market for a female perspective on tech, Shreemani launched her channel with simple, scripted videos that quickly found an audience. Despite experiencing some initial resistance to her presence in the tech space, Shreemani's perseverance paid off. After a few months and around 30 videos, audience trust began to grow — as did her own creator confidence.

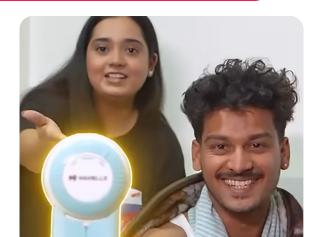
A major turning point came when she embraced a strategy of "easy entertainment," blending tech education with engaging storytelling. Leveraging YouTube Shorts and search optimisation, her channel experienced explosive growth and quickly became a full-time source of income.

Brand deals became the primary revenue driver, complemented by AdSense and affiliate marketing.

Alongside monetisation, YouTube has helped Shreemani build leadership skills, develop a team, and explore Al tools to streamline content creation. The platform has also supported her through events like YouTube's annual Brandcast, which led to more direct brand relationships. With plans to launch educational courses and expand into multilingual tech content (including a kids' channel), Shreemani credits YouTube for giving her both a voice and a platform to dream bigger.

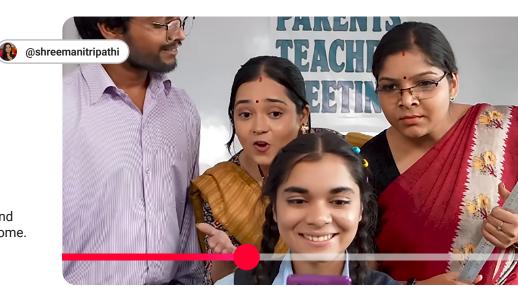

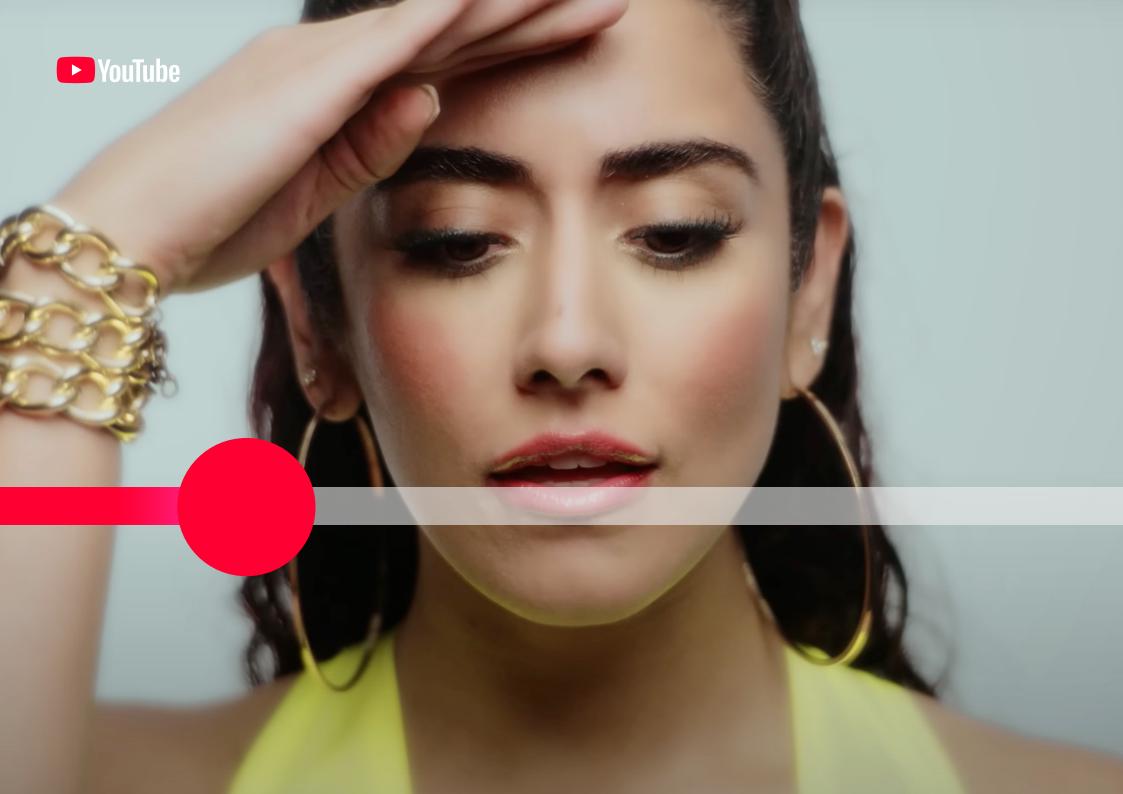

Hanumankind amplified his music career on a more global stage

For Indian rapper, singer, and songwriter Hanumankind, YouTube has been a pivotal force in transforming music from a side passion into a full-fledged creative career. Before launching his channel in 2018, Hanumankind juggled various jobs outside the industry, but he saw YouTube as a unique space where independent artists could build with a like-minded, global audience.

Initially, YouTube was just a platform to share music and "see what stuck". But things changed dramatically in July 2024 with the release of "Big Dawgs", a high-impact music video that marked a major turning point in his career trajectory. This release showcased his full artistic vision, and proved that YouTube could be both a distribution tool and a launchpad for delivering real creative impact.

Hanumankind credits YouTube with helping him level up every aspect of his artistry — from visual storytelling and aesthetics to production and self-promotion. As he's evolved, so has the content: more intentional, more refined, and designed to leave a legacy.

More than just driving views, YouTube has created genuine real-world connections with fans, and allowed Hanumankind to share his roots and tell local stories on a global stage. For this rising artist, YouTube has provided an empowering creative space in which he could find his voice and build a lasting career.

Supporting a thriving media industry

Anita Bokepalli made the seemingly unlikely leap from being one of two women on an offshore oil rig to a thriving YouTube career rooted in mindfulness, self-discovery, and joyful living. Inspired by creators like Lilly Singh and MostlySane, she launched her channel in 2017 with the belief that YouTube could one day be her full-time profession. Despite early challenges, a single authentic video — in which she shared her 4:00am routine — sparked newfound audience engagement. The true breakthrough came in 2021 when she posted a video that showcased her impressive journey to completing 108 Surya Namaskars every day for 30 days, skyrocketing her subscriber base from 3,000 to over 64,000 in a month.

Today, Anita's content spans yoga, conscious eating, and lifestyle transformation. Her videos are primarily discovered through Shorts and browse features, often resonating through topics like daily diet and yoga for wellness. YouTube is the foundation of her business. contributing 100% of her income through AdSense and sponsorships, as well as her online yoga classes.

Bevond monetisation. Anita's channel has cultivated a deeply engaged community - one real-life transformation. From helping viewers reverse health conditions to teaching Art of Living programs funded by her audience, Anita uses YouTube as a platform for impact. With no 'Plan B' career on the horizon, she credits YouTube for giving her both purpose and professional freedom.

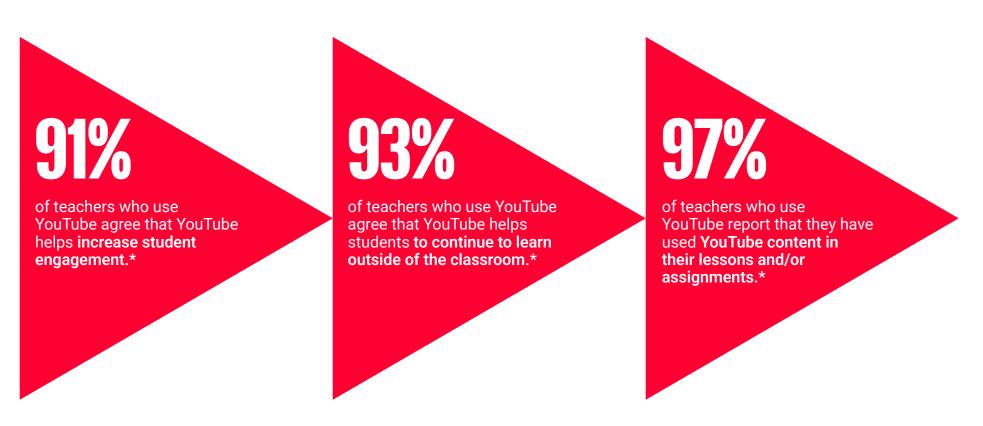

Fit Tuber, founded by former Central Excise Inspector and IT engineer Vivek Mittal, has become one of India's most trusted wellness. channels — thanks in large part to the reach and accessibility of YouTube. Frustrated by the lack of relatable fitness content for everyday audiences. Vivek launched Fit Tuber in 2016 to share practical health advice rooted in Indian traditions. From the outset, he committed to creating meaningful, research-backed videos aimed at helping people like his parents and peers improve their lives through simple, actionable changes.

The channel gained momentum when Vivek shifted from trending fitness topics to original, value-driven content, like reviews of everyday products and natural remedies.

This authenticity resonated deeply with viewers, and YouTube's recommendation engine amplified his reach. Today, Vivek's channel sustains his own full-time career and a team of seven remote collaborators.

YouTube generates all of Fit Tuber's income, primarily through AdSense and sponsorships allowing him to keep his videos free for viewers. In addition to fuelling an income, YouTube has empowered Vivek to grow professionally, connect with millions, and make a tangible difference to people's health and wellbeing. From planting trees locally to transforming viewers' lifestyles globally, Fit Tuber's journey shows how YouTube can turn a simple idea into a platform for impact, education, and purpose.

Labour Law Advisor brings employment

Launched by Rishabh Jain and Mandeep Gill, Labour Law Advisor began as an experiment with no expectations — just a shared drive to simplify complex topics like labour laws. personal finance, and tax for Indian adults. Combining Rishabh's access to legal expertise with Mandeep's video skills, the duo posted their first few videos in 2017. They quickly realised they were filling a massive content gap explaining employment benefits like EPF, ESI, and gratuity from the employee's perspective.

clarity and confidence to millions

After years of trial and error, their true breakthrough came with deeply personal content - including a video on insurance misselling that was born from Mandeep's own family experience. That video, and others like it, resonated with viewers who had long felt overlooked by mainstream financial education. The response was overwhelming as viewers thanked them for helping to recover lost funds, understand policy traps, and make smarter financial decisions.

Today, Labour Law Advisor has built a thriving business ecosystem around their channel. including online courses, a successful stationery brand (Jagruk Journal), and brand collaborations. YouTube's platform and audience enabled their message to reach millions while unlocking full-time careers for both founders and enabling them to build a 30+ person team.

More than content creators, they see themselves as educators and activists - using YouTube not just to inform, but to empower Indians all over the country with life-changing financial knowledge.

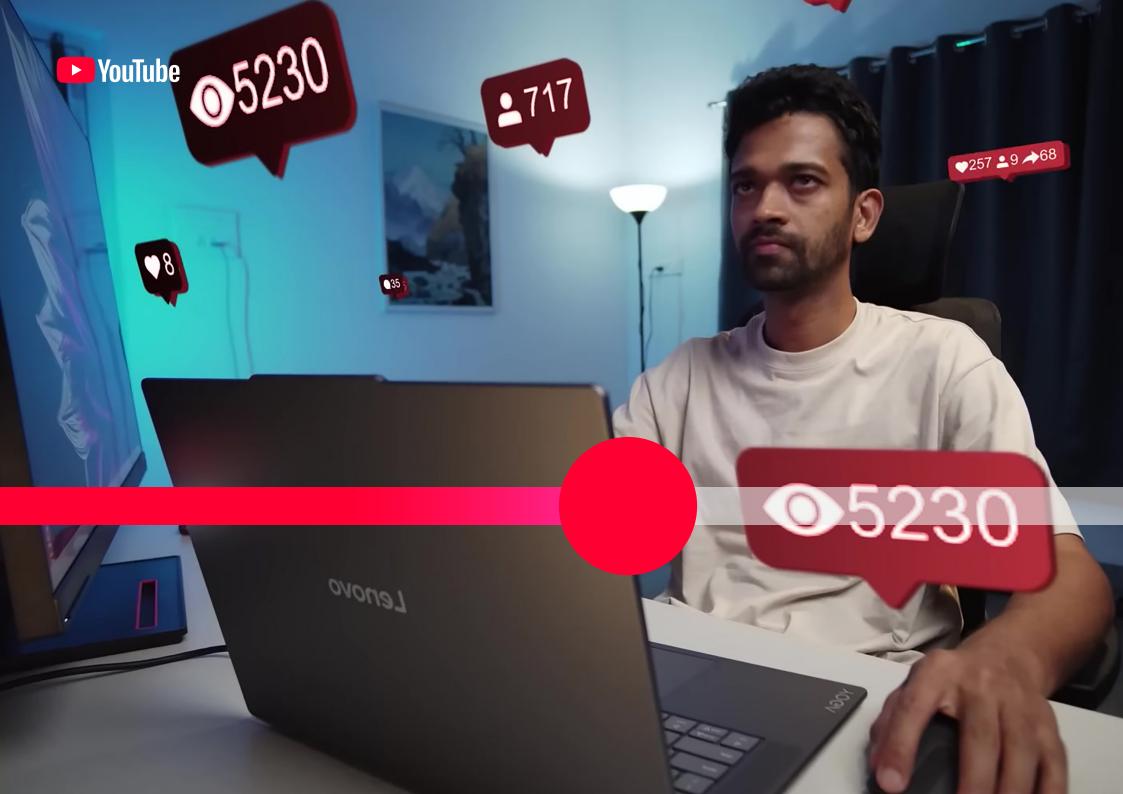
