You will soon be able to use your company smartphone for personal use too. There's no need to carry two phones anymore!



Protecting your personal privacy

Your corporate phone will automatically separate work and personal apps using the work profile, this helps keep things separate, and ensures your personal privacy is protected. Work apps will have a briefcase badge on them so you can quickly identify which apps are for work and keep them separate from your personal profile.

Work apps behave differently to personal apps. For example, you may not be able to take screenshots in work apps. You might not be able to copy and paste work data into your personal apps, either. This is to protect company data from being accidentally shared to public domains.

Conversely, your company cannot view, install, or configure apps on the personal side, nor can they reset your password, or prevent you from removing your personal data via a factory reset of your device.



Installing new apps

Use your personal Google Play Store to install apps for your personal use.

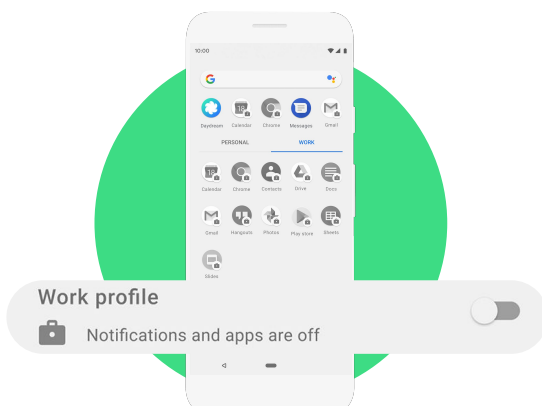
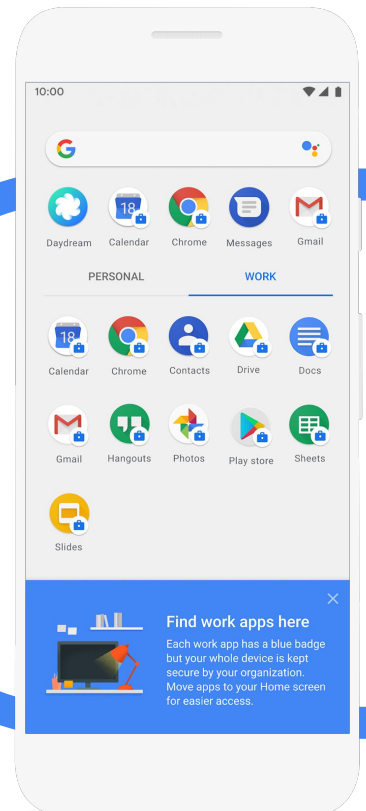
Work-related apps can be automatically installed by your IT team or made available through the work-badged Google Play Store.



Turning off from work

Your work apps can be turned off at any time so you can enjoy your personal time, privately, without any work distractions. When off, work apps will gray out, and you will not receive new notifications until you turn your work apps back on.

Switch work apps off or on by swiping down from the top of your screen, or by using the work profile toggle at the bottom of your app tray.
