



Direct Trial Kickoff in Admin Console


If starting a trial in your Admin Console please familiarize yourself with these actions

- A Google Workspace Super Administrator will need to complete these actions

Reseller Trial Kickoff

If utilizing a preferred <u>Reseller</u>, please familiarize yourself with the Reseller Token Transfer that will take place to allocate licenses

- Transfer your account to a reseller details reseller's access and process to execute
- Reseller's limitations within a customer's Admin console
- <u>Change a reseller's access to your account</u> post roll out of licenses for trial, you can perform this action


